CLOSE OF VOTING: 23.59 BST ON 30 APRIL 2021

In order to ensure that diversity of representation is achieved the following rules and limits on the number of Representatives electable from Constituent Organisations and Countries are in place:

In the European and Latin American regions:

- a) no more than one Representative may be elected from one IPA Constituent Organisation;
- b) no more than 2 Representatives may be elected from one country.

In the North America region and for the United States of America only:

- a) No more than 5 Representatives may be elected from the Regional Association (APsaA); with no more than one Representative from each Affiliate Society of APsaA, and
- b) No more than 2 Representatives may be elected from the Independent Societies; with no more than one Representative from each Independent Society, but
- c) No more than 6 Representatives may be elected from the United States of America in total.

In the North America region, apart from the United States of America:

- a) No more than one Representative may be elected from one IPA Constituent Organisation and
- b) No more than 2 Representatives may be elected from one country.

Subject to the limits above, those candidates who receive the most votes will be elected.
