Traumatic experiences can impact our patients in a variety of ways, disturbing, destabilising and restricting their internal functioning, their experiences and their relationships. These challenges can be usefully understood and made sense of through subconscious communications between patient and analyst. In this seminar / discussion group Dr. Wolfe will share experiences she has had with patients where she experienced a number of visceral and emotional reactions, through which she was gradually able to make some sense of the patient's experience of and response to their trauma. She will discuss how she worked to make sense of these experiences through exploring her own reactions, and responded in different ways – sometimes by sharing via interpretation, and sometimes by recognising that the patient needed alternate care.

A large part of this session will be a discussion of Candidate experiences of patient trauma in their consulting room, and an exploration of ways these can be understood and managed. All references to clinical material will be edited to preserve confidentiality,
